Village Green and G. Dana Holt Gazebo

Guidelines for Use – Adopted October 18, 2004

The Village Green was established in 1997 with the purchase of property and the razing of buildings located at 61 Main Street. At that time, the citizens of Dixfield were interested in creating a “green space” for a park. The park would be used for outdoor weddings, musical concerts, resting/visiting spot, house the town Christmas tree, provide some off-street parking and include an information kiosk. Today, most of the original plans have materialized.

Please read the following list of guidelines that were approved by the Board of Selectmen on October 18, 2004 for use of the park. Sign and date the bottom of the page and return to the Dixfield Town Office:

- The Dixfield Town Office is responsible for scheduling special events in the park.
- Dixfield citizens will be given priority when using the park for a scheduled event; after that, scheduling will be done on a “first come, first served” basis.
- The Village Green and the G. Dana Holt Gazebo must be left in the same (or in better) condition as when it was found.
- Absolutely no nails, staples, tacks or screws can be used to attach anything to the existing structures, trees or plant life. Wire ties, pipe cleaners and tape are acceptable and may be used.
- The brick walkways must be swept only; do **NOT** use a hose to clean the bricks.
- The user of the park must provide trash receptacles.
- Please be respectful of “Bullrock” and the plantings.
