## Spring Clean-Up Notice

**Monday May 6th through Friday May 17, 2019**

Residents are encouraged to bring items to the Transfer Station during Spring Clean-Up, if possible, and there will be no charge for disposal of any items. A current Transfer Station decal sticker is required on your vehicle and is available at the Town Office, 46 Main Street, Dixfield, ME. **OCCUPIED RESIDENTIAL PROPERTIES ONLY**  
**ABSOLUTELY NO HOUSEHOLD GARBAGE**

**Items to be picked up by Public Works and kept separated by type:**

**Leaves and Garden Waste:** DO NOT RAKE INTO ROAD and must be in *ONE single pile*.

**All Metals:** Scrap metal and metal appliances, **maximum of 2:** such as 1 refrigerator and 1 air conditioner

**Brush:** Brush and vines **smaller than 1 inch** in diameter must be **tied in bundles with string or twine**, no wires. **Larger brush**, with maximum diameter of 6 inches, **will be chipped**. Please place with the butt end near the road.

**Tires:** Maximum of 4 tires per household. Only passenger car tires will be picked up.

**The following items will NOT be picked up by Public Works:**

Refrigerators with doors attached, automobiles, car batteries, commercial truck tires, skidder tires, propane cylinders, rocks, bricks, concrete, chemicals, paint, cardboard, firewood, tree stumps or demolished buildings.

**The following items may be brought to the Transfer Station:**

Propane cylinders, rocks, bricks and firewood

**The total amount of all items taken from each residence must not exceed ONE PICKUP truck load.**
